

Covid-19 Update 25th March 2020

The Chief Dental Officer for England and the UK Government have released new guidance on the provision of dentistry in the UK. This is for all NHS and Private practices across England. The new guidance is summarised as below:

1 - All routine, non-urgent dental care including orthodontics should be stopped and deferred until advised otherwise.

2 - All practices should establish a remote urgent care service, providing telephone triage for their patients with urgent needs during usual working hours, and whenever possible treating with:

- Advice
- Analgesia
- Antimicrobial means where appropriate

This means for our patients, if you have an urgent dental emergency, please call us on 01204 373555 and you will be directed to Dr Morar.

Following the guidance above, we cannot see or treat patients in our normal manner. We can offer you telephone advice and possibly antibiotics, if necessary.

If you have symptoms of Covid-19, or you are in a household where someone is self isolating, we cannot see you in person. We will need to take your details and refer you to a secondary care service where personnel with the correct personal protective equipment (PPE) are stationed and equipped to treat patients.
