

True Dentistry Operating Procedure – From 4th July 2022

True Dentistry has been safely operating a Covid Safe Operating Procedure since June 2020.

In June 2022, there has been a de-escalation of Covid Safety Protocols required by dental practices and we now feel we can safely move to a deescalated Operating Procedure without any staff or patient harm occurring.

As such the Practice will be moving to a Pre-Covid Operating Procedure from 4th July 2022.

What are the changes you will see as Patients?

- We will still communicate with you via text and email as was the norm pre-Covid.
- The Car Park is still available for use, although there is no entry to the Practice from the back of the building. Please park considerately.
- The front door to the Practice will now be the single point of Entry and Exit.
- The back door will revert to becoming a Fire Exit and this will **not** be available for bringing patients in and out of the Practice
- The Waiting Room and the Practice Toilets will be open for use
- Please continue to update your Medical History the day before your appointment via the email sent to you.
- We will cease to record your temperature on entry to the Practice and we will no longer require loose items to be deposited in the clear boxes.
- Alcohol gel will be available on request, but it will not be mandatory to use it
- Face masks will be a personal choice. It will not be mandatory to wear them to enter the Practice or in the Public Areas

If you feel unwell before you attend, please **DO NOT ATTEND THE PRACTICE**. Call us and we will rearrange the appointment.
